

## POSTGRADUATE PROGRAM ON FAMILY IN CONTEMPORARY SOCIETY

### DESCRIPTION

The **Postgraduate Program on Family in Contemporary Society** (PPGFSC) completes 16 years of existence in 2020 and offers master's and doctoral courses. Its purpose is to investigate, in an interdisciplinary perspective, the changes experienced in contemporary families.

The PPGFSC promotes the debate on interpersonal relationships in the domestic sphere, as well as those established between society, the State and family (s), in different socioeconomic and cultural contexts.

It stands out for its in-depth, updated and critical training in epistemological, theoretical, methodological and technical terms in an approach to family. It is a space for teaching, research, extension and mobility.

### CONCENTRATION AREA

The Program's focus area is "Family in Change". This choice comes from the understanding that, just as there are several changes in contemporary society, the family also changes and reorganizes itself.

### GOALS

The objectives of the Program are:

- forming researchers, at the master's and doctoral levels, able to investigate, think and intervene in the family phenomenon, in an interdisciplinary perspective;
- promote and disseminate scientific knowledge about the family in contemporary society;
- interpret legal relations and legal norms from an interdisciplinary perspective;
- subsidize social interventions that affect the family;
- establish a mobility program and networks for the dissemination of knowledge about the family, both nationally and internationally.

University professors, psychologists, sociologists, philosophers, law graduates, educators, social workers, doctors, nurses, physiotherapists and professionals from other areas of knowledge who are interested in studying the family from an interdisciplinary perspective.
